Dear Parents!
We would like to congratulate your child on successfully completing the first Unit. We also appreciate your contribution and support in his/her journey of learning. Usually by the end of the first Unit most children are well settled. They are familiar with the routine of the Centre and more comfortable with their surroundings. They are also made aware of the rules of conduct and they are expected to show more compliance.

Though our basic approach to learning remains the same and the methodologies of active learning are essentially similar, there are certain things that change as children gradually move to more complex ideas and concepts.
